PREPARING TO USE ZOOM FOR ONLINE MEETINGS

- 1. You can use Zoom from a smartphone, a tablet or a computer. But first, you must download and install the Zoom app:
 - iPhone and iPad users should visit the Apple App Store to download and install the Zoom app on their device. Android users should visit the Google Play Store to download and install the app.
 - If you are using Zoom from a desktop or laptop computer, download the Zoom app by visiting https://zoom.us, then select Resources located at the top of the page, and select Download Zoom Client. Finally, click or tap the blue Download button under Zoom Client for Meetings and select Run when prompted.
- 2. Regardless of whether you are using a smartphone, tablet or computer the second step is to create a Zoom account:
 - Within the Zoom app select Sign Up and follow the prompts.
 - After you have entered your email address and name (and agreed to the terms), Zoom will send you an email. Open the email and click or tap the blue button that reads **Activate Account**.
 - At this point, you will be asked to select a password. Setting a password is the last step in creating your Zoom user account.
 - Finally, sign into your Zoom account.

ATTEND A ZOOM ONLINE MEETING

- To join a meeting, you must first locate a meeting. Find one by visiting
 https://sites.google.com/view/bayareazoomaameetings to see a list of the available Zoom meetings arranged by day of the week.
- 2. Locate an online meeting that meets on the day that you would like to attend. Online meetings are held the same day and time that its corresponding face-to-face meeting is regularly held.
- 3. Click or tap the **Join Zoom Meeting** link for the meeting that you would like to attend. Doing so will automatically launch the Zoom app that you previously installed. You will be in the Zoom meeting that you selected and you will be able to see your fellow meeting attendees.

NOTE: Please keep in mind that people will be able to see your surroundings as well as hear what is going on around you. As a courtesy, please **mute** your Zoom app while you are not speaking.
